Sticky Walls Wall Art Instructions

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| | <p>1. Clean Your Wall or Surface</p> <p>In order for your Sticky Walls Wall Art to stick, you need a clean, dry and smooth surface free of dust and dirt. To ensure your surface is clean and dust free, take a DRY cloth and wipe the area. DO NOT use a wet cloth. Go slow during the application especially with decals that are detailed; large decals may require a friend to help you apply it. Sticky Walls Wall Art can be applied to walls, wood, glass, concrete, metal or any smooth, dry surface. Sticky Walls Wall Art is removable but may not be repositioned or reused.</p> <p>Do not apply to freshly painted walls! Wait a minimum of 2 weeks after painting.</p> |
| | <p>2. Prep Your Lettering & Plan Your Layout</p> <p>Your lettering will arrive with application tape, so make sure you have allowed sufficient time for the lettering to unfold and lay flat. Be sure to remove the lettering from its original rolled up state at least an hour before application. Take a squeegee/credit card and firmly press on the lettering several times to adhere it to the application tape. You will see this prevents the lettering from hanging on the wax paper backing. Arrange your Sticky Walls Wall Art on your surface using masking tape (on the top edge only), do not remove the white backing until you are happy with your layout.</p> |
| | <p>3. Apply the Vinyl Wall Art</p> <p>Flip the wall art up. Starting from any corner, slowly peel the white backing paper away from the transfer tape; the vinyl decal should be sticking to the transfer tape. If some of the decal remains stuck to the white backing, STOP and rub the decal in that area and slowly continue peeling until the white backing is completely removed. As you lower your Sticky Walls Decal against the surface carefully move your hand slowly across the decal, starting at the top center and working your way out to the edges and bottom of the decal. With your finger or credit card finish the application by rubbing over the entire graphic to remove any air bubbles.</p> |
| | <p>4. Remove the Application Tape</p> <p>Slowly and carefully pull up an edge of the clear transfer paper and peel away at a 180-degree angle along the face of the wall. Make sure that no part of the vinyl is left attached to the transfer paper. If this does happen, stop pulling and re-press the vinyl to the wall through the transfer paper, then continue to slowly peel off the transfer paper and discard. – ENJOY YOUR WORK!!!!</p> |
